Assistant Team Manager Key Responsibilities

- To support the Team Manager to deliver the tour objectives
- To support the Team Manager as required in coordinating and delivering upon tour logistics, schedules and operational tasks as required
- To assist the Team Manager is creating and distributing comprehensive and time appropriate team communications
- Re-enforce and uphold the Team values
- Support the wider management team in ensuring that the Australian Life Saving Team adopts a high-performance mentality to all aspects of the tour
- Consistently maintain and embody a high standard of integrity and respectful behaviour to all team members
- Adhere to and implement organisational and team codes of conduct and policies as outlined in the Team Agreement
- Report any breaches of organisational, team codes of conduct and policy during camps / training / competition to the Team Manager or through the RLSSA complaints process
- Always ensure the wellbeing of all the team members remains the top priority
- Assess and manage risk in all team associated activities
- Travel with team to events and camps as required
- Attend Team Manager briefings in the Team Managers absence if required
- Support the Team Manager to maintain a consistent and high level of communication with key stakeholders, including but not limited to athletes, parents/carers, event organisers, key officials, and SLSA and RLSSA staff
- Support the Team Manager with lodging official team protests in competition as required
- Support the Team Manager efforts to deliver the tour within the dedicated budget

- Assist the Team Manager with all day-to-day team logistics and operations on tour
- Contribute to the post camp and post event reports, including a submission of tour results within one month following the activity

- Demonstrated leadership skills

- Able to manage time and follow assigned tasks whilst having own initiative
- Motivated and results driven
- Team orientated and contributes to the creation of a positive team culture and identity
- Highly passionate about the success of the Australian Life Saving Team
- Possess a current driver's license

Assistant Team Manager Requirements

- Complete all required Team administration/documentation on time
- Follow up with the team to ensure team documentation is completed on time
- Assist the Team Manager as required to create accurate and timely post camp / tour event reports, within one month following the activity to be reported on against measures outlined in the campaign plan
- Contribute to a post event / tour debrief with the ALT as an investment into continuous learning
- Works with RLSSA National Manager Lifesaving Development to review post event surveys to enhance learnings and delivery for future tours
- The successful applicant is required to undergo probity checks which include Reference checks and a Working with Children Check before commencement. Appointment is subject to clearance of all these checks.
